

Today is the third Sunday of Advent! Today we light the pink candle, the candle of Joy. The pink candle, known as the Gaudete (rejoice, from Latin translation of Phil 4:4) candle, marks a moment of celebration during the otherwise reflective and repentant season. Its origins come from early church traditions, where Advent mirrored the somber tone of Lent, and the third Sunday provided a joyful reprieve. The color pink symbolizes this shift to rejoicing as we draw closer to the celebration of Christ's birth and the joy of his presence in the world. Next Sunday's candle is the candle of Love.
