

We give and send supplies because of the relationship; the relationship we have with Jesus and the relationship we have with our brothers and sisters in Zimbabwe. What difference does that relationship make? Because of our long standing relationship with Ishe Anesu, six of the children from Ishe Anesu have gone on to become missionaries in other parts of the world through the General Board of Global Ministries of the United Methodist Church. You helped make that happen with every food bucket you filled. They wanted to serve others the way you have served them. Thank you for leaning into your relationship with Jesus and with Ishe Anesu."
